- Instill confidence to lead in a global environment


Program Structure



- No Participation Fee for students participating through TiE
 Rajasthan
- Students brainstorm a business idea in a team of upto 5 members
- Submit the business idea to TiE as a write up
- Selected teams prepare plan for a Business Plan Competition under guidance of an assigned TiE mentor who is a CEO / senior professional from the industry
- Compete the Business Plan Competition at TiE Chapter level
- Chapter winners are mentored further to compete globally at the US competition
- Awards worth US\$ 10000

Phases & Timelines









- Students must be in Grades 9 12 (or in equivalent college grades)
- Strong interest in entrepreneurship
- Commitment to complete the program
